## **Lotto designs and Lotto numbers**

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A  $(n, k, p, t)$ -Lotto design is an  $n$ -set  $N$  and a set  $\mathcal{B}$  of  $k$ -subsets of  $N$  (called blocks), so that for each  $p$ -subset  $P$  of  $N$ , there is a block  $B \in \mathcal{B}$  for which  $|P \cap B| \geq t$ . The Lotto number  $L(n, k, p, t)$  denotes the smallest number of blocks in a  $(n, k, p, t)$ -lotto design. We will discuss a few problems related to the determination of Lotto numbers and the construction of Lotto designs.
